

1. THE 391 Mariology 3 sem. hours **Monsignor Arthur Calkins, STD**

Description: A Scriptural, historical, and theological study of the Church's understanding of Mary in Sacred Scripture, and in the tradition of the Church from the Patristic Era through Vatican II to the significant contribution of St. John Paul II. Mary's relationship to Christ, her participation in the mysteries of His life, and her role as Mother of the Church will be investigated.

2. THE 491 Gender Identity 3 sem. hrs **Jennifer Miller, STD**

Description: What does it mean to be a human person? What does it mean to be a man or a woman? Is my gender imposed on me, or is it something that I can create? This course is an interdisciplinary introduction to gender and its implications. Beginning with the questions posed by contemporary gender theory, it explores how gender and sexuality are understood in Scripture and by various feminine and masculine voices within the Christian tradition. Upon this basis, it then involves students in examining and challenging current familial, economic, and social structures.

Registration Information


Aquinas Institute (AI) courses are offered either for college credit or for catechetical instruction. AI credit student enrollees who meet the admission requirements of the University of Holy Cross (UHC) shall be admitted to UHC via electronic admissions, enrollment, and registration. If ACT scores are not available, the student will be permitted to take an ACCU-PLACER placement test at UHC at no cost. AI students for credit must be in compliance with the deadlines that are published on the UHC website (<http://www.uhcno.edu/>).

Tuition and Fees

Tuition for a 3 credit hour course is \$1054 plus \$100 fees (for a total of \$1154) and paid directly to the University of Holy Cross. AI credit students who work directly for the Church (e.g., educators, priests, deacons, religious, DRE's, etc.) in a full or part time capacity will be offered a special rate of 1/3 tuition (\$350 plus \$50 fees or a total of \$400) provided that at least three (3) such persons attend. AI catechetical students will register directly with Aquinas Institute and the tuition (\$200 per course) is paid directly to Aquinas Institute (a course registration form for catechetical students is available at www.aquinaslafayette.org).
